Instructor Anna Hopkins-Arnold has been teaching about DNA and inheritance since 1992, took her first genealogy DNA test in 2006 and has used DNA to break through brick walls and prove family connections. She will share information concerning Autosomal DNA Testing, a wonderful tool to push forward your genealogy research. Anna will help participants better understand:

- ◆ what DNA is and how we inherit the DNA segments we do
- ◆ terms for describing what we learn about DNA
- ◆ what we learn about our DNA cousin matches

This class is designed to help participants understand how DNA testing works, plan which family members to test first to get the best value for your DNA testing dollars, and learn how your DNA matches go hand-in-hand with traditional document-based research to help you learn more about your family tree. Discussion will also include ethical considerations when asking others to test, and when presenting any results that include information about living people.
